POOL PRICES

Swimmers have two options to enjoy the pool, a season pass or daily admission charge. Everyone entering the pool must show their ID. Children age two and younger enter free.

General Admission \$5 a day

Season Passes

Individual	\$75
Family of 2	\$100
Family of 3	\$115
Family of 4	\$125

* Add \$15 for each additional member

FISH PASS

Pool management recommends dependants with military ID ages 11-13 obtain a pool Fish Pass so lifeguards may identify patrons as proficient swimmers. With a Fish Pass, youth may swim unattended at the pool. Fish Passes will be issued only when a child can swim 40 feet, tread water for one minute and pull themselves from the water without using the pool ladder. The passes are free and are valid the entire pool season.



POOL PARTIES

Host the best party of the summer by celebrating your next big event at the Aviation Cadet Pool! Packages are available for squadron functions, birthday parties, and more! Reservations may be requested for an after hours party any day of the week. Two weeks notice is preferred.

All parties are required to have lifeguards present. The number of lifeguards is determined by AFI 34-110.

The pool has a slide, basketball goal, locker rooms and an eating area, where outside food and drink are allowed. Alcoholic beverages may be served during pool parties only with written authorization from the 42 FSS Commander.

YOUTH SWIM TEAM

Youth Ages 5-17 can register for swim team from April 17 until full. **Registration is at Maxwell and Gunter Youth Centers from 2:30-5 p.m., Monday - Friday.** Members pay \$60 for the season, non-members pay \$80; the season runs June-July. A sports physical is required for all participants.

YOUTH GROUP SWIM LESSONS

Group Swim Lessons will be held at the Aviation Cadet Pool. Sessions include 8 lessons from 8 - 10:30 a.m. Children can be enrolled in any level of swimming based on their ability.

Sessions are \$70 per child for 8 lessons. Registration begins in May and continues until sessions are filled.

GENERAL RULES

Violation of pool rules may result in termination of aquatic facilities

- All patrons must show proper ID and pool passes
- Report any medical conditions to staff upon arrival
- Everyone must shower before entering the pool
- Ages 10 and younger must be supervised by an adult
- Children ages 11-13 need a Fish Pass with military ID
- Only non-oil base sun block is permitted
- Individuals experiencing the following conditions are prohibited from entering the pool: diarrhea, skin disease, open sores/lesions, sore/inflamed eyes and nasal or ear discharge
- Only swim suits are permitted in pools
- Swim diapers are required for children not potty-trained
- No horseplay allowed in or around the pool
- No glass containers allowed in the pool area
- Only drinks are allowed in plastic or paper containers at chairs; no food
- Smoking is prohibited in and around the pool facility
- Staff is not responsible for items left at the pool facility
- Patrons must be able to swim to use slides; clear the area under the slides after sliding
- Children age 13 and younger must clear the pool during 10-minute pool breaks
- No standing on or jumping off large floats
- Water wings are prohibited
- Parents are responsible for watching their children
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved life vests are allowed in the pool Tuesday-Friday. During weekends and holidays noodles and soft floats are permitted, as long as it is not a primary source of floatation

- Diving is only permitted in the 9 ft. deep area
- No breath holding or prolonged underwater swimming competitions allowed
- No chewing gum in or around the swimming pool
- No pets are allowed in the pool area; with the exception of certified service dogs
- Lap swim hours are designated for lap swimmers; other patrons may not enter the facility to wait on the deck or for use of the splash pad
